President's Message



Matthew Jehs, MAI

It is clear that 2020 will be a challenging and disruptive time for our real estate appraisal community, but I hope our members, candidates, and affiliates can find opportunities and optimism in the midst of the largest healthcare crisis of our generation. Our good fortune over the last several years in an appreciating economy has allowed many of us to expand into new markets and explore new property types or lines of business, but with the unprecedented market challenges ahead of us it is more important than ever to understand the economic drivers for your local markets and the key property types of your practice.

Most appraisers are going to be at the forefront of understanding, analyzing, and communicating how the fallout will impact commercial and residential real estate. With the introduction of social distancing to the collective psyche, whenever the public health risk lessens, it is very difficult to know if traditional group behavior will return to many localities. The “invisible nature” of this crisis represents a new set of challenges with respect to risk and functionality. For example, will commercial tenants require future rent abatements to coincide with forced government closures? Will home offices shoot to the top of residential buyer demands and properties without them begin to lag? These questions become even more challenging with few recent sales and general uncertainty about the resolution of this outbreak.

This means ongoing discussions with sale/leasing brokers, buyers/sellers, developers/investors and bankers regarding their market/submarket observations, any trends, sales patterns, price reductions, increases in sales/lease listings, and changes in rental, sales, and absorption patterns. Any or all of these might be impacted.

Speaking of opportunities, one of the most significant changes to our local chapter has been to how we deliver education to our members in a recertification year. *The East Florida Chapter can now facilitate our approved classes in a virtual format though the end of November.* While many of you may have considered taking AI sponsored or even non-AI classes, our chapter is working diligently to make CE as safe and convenient as possible. The classes are interactive; students must have video and audio capability to see/hear the instructor and the instructor must be able to see/hear the students during the entire class. But it significantly expands the number of class offerings that could be done remotely and that can provide both Florida CE and AI CE credit (see page 6).

If you missed the recent AI Webinar on the Market Impacts of COVID-19, I highly recommend every member check it out. The webinar showcases the power that our collective appraisal body of knowledge can wield, including great insights on the potential impacts of the COVID crisis on a wide array of property types.
